SUMMER COURSES FOR STUDENTS AGED 8 – 17

The Camden centre is in a quiet, residential area, close to the London Zoo, museums, attractions and galleries of Central London. Students can choose between 15, 21 and 25 hours of lessons per week.

All lessons include a “discover London” trip study visit per week and a packed lunch every day. 21 and 25 hour courses also include a sport session or a local walk each week.

HOME-STAY ACCOMMODATION:

All our families have been selected for their warmth and their welcome rather than their proximity to the schools, however they are situated in safe residential areas of London which are very well connected by public transports.

The families reflect the multi-cultural aspect of Britain, although they may come from any ethnic background, English is their mother tongue.

Juniors are accommodated on a full board basis with the midday meal provided at school, on school days and at home during the weekend.

There may be up to three students staying in the accommodation at the same time, but of different mother tongue, unless otherwise requested.

ACCOMMODATION WITH SELF-CATERING:

On request we can provide a vast choices of accommodation as follows: hostels, apartments and house shares, halls of residence shared homes, apartments and studios, all of a very good standard, located in central London and offering the most modern comforts.

ACTIVITIES:

Activities are organized on a monthly basis. The majority are free and range from visits to museums to picnics in the park, to visits to the Olympic site to visit to the several London markets and London pubs. However for groups, on request, we can organize London walks (Jack the Ripper walk, The Harry Potter walk) visits to sport venues Chelsea or the Emirates football stadium, Wimbledon, Ascot, nights at the theatre and more.

TRANSFERS:
