HOW TO GET TO CHURCHILL HOUSE, RAMSGATE

The shared transfer at all airports on arrival operates between 07:00 hrs and 19:00 hours (waiting time 0 – 3 hours) and on departure for flights leaving between 10.30 hours and 21.00 hours.

All students are met at the flight arrival gate on arrival.

Individual taxis are available on any arrival day at any time from any arrival point – airport, railway station, ferry port etc.

Students who have chosen to travel independently will be sent precise train and coach information when booking a course.

SUPERVISION OF HOME-STAY JUNIORS

At Churchill House the safety of our junior students is our prime concern. We ensure that they are always under the supervision of our trained staff whether in class or participating in activities.

Our Home-stay junior students are placed in experienced families. Each centre has a junior liaison officer responsible for overall supervision.

Social Club excursion tickets are sold to junior students aged 15 and under on the understanding that they agree to stay with the staff escort, group leader or another responsible adult at all times. After full day coach trips we arrange for students to leave the coach close to their families and after evening activities, Activity Leaders will ensure that their students get home safely.

Taxis are cheap and can be arranged easily.

Please note that Children aged 10 and 11 must have a Residential Course.

HOME-STAY ACCOMMODATION

Students choose between a single and shared room. Shared room is normally with a student of a different nationality. Host families for our students are situated in Ramsgate and all are located at a walk distance from the school.

SELF-CATERING ACCOMMODATION

Students stay in single en-suite rooms in flats of 5 bedrooms in the Christchurch University campus accommodation at Northwood Court. Each flat has a kitchen/dining room and there is a central laundry facility. All self-catering students are provided with bus passes to journey the short distance to and from school. For this kind of accommodation there is a supplement of £20 a week.

EXTRA NIGHTS

Home-stay and Self-catering = £25 per night.

LESSON TIMES

Students receive 3 hours actual teaching per day, totalling 15 hours per week.

POCKET MONEY

Student's pocket money may be deposited with the centre either before or on arrival. Notice of 2 days must be given when large amounts of pocket money are required.

Young Adult students taking a Home-stay course who have not booked full board will need to bring approximately £30 per week for lunches, plus the cost of any additional trips they wish to take from the Social Club General Programme, in addition to their personal spending money.

Junior students should also consider approximately £10 per week to cover the cost of taxi transport home after evening activities.

EXCURSIONS

Courses can be booked with an Excursion Programme of 1 weekend and 1 midweek coach excursion per week. All excursions are normally by coach and are escorted by Churchill House staff/guides. Prices include admission costs and official guides where applicable.

TYPICAL EXCURSIONS

Brighton, Cambridge, Canterbury, Dicken's World, Dover Castle, Leeds Castle, London, Oxford, Windsor Castle & Eton.

MULTI-DAY TOURS

Tours to Scotland, Paris, Amsterdam, Belgium, English Lake District, Liverpool/Manchester and weekends in London can all be arranged and combined with a Summer Course.

If you want to book extra trips and tours you can choose from the Summer Social Club Programme and we will invoice you for the correct amount.

ACTIVITIES

Students have a daily choice of daytime (4 per week) and evening activities (5 per week). Junior Ramsgate home-stay students aged 15 and under have their own dorms for evening activities.

Young Adult and Adult Ramsgate home-stay students use the main dorm.

DAYTIME ACTIVITIES

During each activity session there are a number of different activities to choose from including Dance Classes, Aerobics, Football, Basketball, Tennis, Art Classes, Swimming to name just a few.

At a single session there is a choice of up to 5 different activities for the students to choose from.

Students receive instruction regarding the rules of each of the activities and have time to practise the necessary skills before the game periods. At the end of each week a Churchill House Tournament is held where students compete for points in the various activities – prizes and certificates are awarded. All activities are run by experienced Activity Leaders and each activity period is split into 2 sessions with a short break in between, for changeover of activities and refreshment.

EVENING ACTIVITIES

A wide range of evening activities are run for our students including Bingo, Quiz nights, Cultural Evenings, Karaoke's, Disco's and the famous Churchill House Cabaret in which students can demonstrate their individual talents. Each week we run a Nationality Party enabling groups to run their own party with national dances, food and the different aspects of their culture.

SPECIAL 'STAR' ACTIVITIES

Run by professional coaches available to all Ramsgate students at a supplementary cost.

- Water Sports – sailing, windsurfing, kayaking arranged locally in Joss Bay and in Dover.
- Football Coaching – specialist coaching from Charlton Athletic Football Club and stadium tour.
- Tennis Coaching – students receive specialist coaching from an LTA tennis coach.
- Horse Riding – cross country riding, hacks and general training with horses at a British Certified Riding School.

Other Information

INSURANCE

It is now a legal requirement to take out an insurance policy to cover students against travel and medical problem and cancellations or termination of the course. The school offers an insurance policy designed for students of English UK schools at £5 per week.

RESERVATION

To avoid having too many students of any one nationality at the school at any one time there are a limited number of places on every course for each nationality. Reservation should therefore be made as early as possible.

To make a reservation for a number of group places we must receive:

- The Group Reservation Form with as much detail as possible about the group.
- A deposit of £150 GBP per student to be irrevocably credited to our bank account for the exact number of places to be reserved.
- Deposit for July courses must be paid by April 15th and for August courses by May 15th.
- The balance of the total group invoice must be credited to our bank account no later than 21 days before the arrival date.

The Enrolment Form on its own though does not constitute a reservation and does not guarantee availability of places.

On receipt of the Enrolment Form we will send a Proforma invoice together with a Student Details Form which must be completed and returned to us with the full and final details of the students in the group no less than 30 days before the arrival date.

ENROLMENT

We cannot guarantee acceptance of any group or part of a group until a reservation has been properly made as detailed below. We reserve the right to refuse the enrolment of any student for any reason including inappropriate level of English.

You should also pay a deposit of £150.00 per student at the same time.

PAYMENT

The deposit must be paid when you book your course. It is also possible to make full payment of fees at this stage. Full payment details will be provided.

When we have received your enrolment form and £150.00 deposit (per student) we will reserve the course and accommodation for you and send you a Certificate of Enrolment confirming your course dates and the total price.

Please note: We must receive full payment for your course at least 21 days before you arrive.

Cancellations

If you cancel your course because your visa application was refused we will refund 100% of fees paid on receipt of the original written visa refusal.

If you cancel your course or accommodation up to 21 days before the start date, we will refund the total fees paid minus the deposit. If you cancel your course less than 21 days before the start date, the full value of all fees paid, minus the deposit, will be transferred to another course of your choice at a later date.

If you wish to cancel all or part of your course or accommodation after your arrival 4 weeks' notice must be given. The balance of the accommodation fees will be refunded in full and the balance of the tuition fees will be transferred to another course at a later date. If less than the required notice period is given, 4 week's tuition and accommodation fees will still be deducted from the remaining balance.

CANCELLATIONS AND CHANGES FOR GROUPS

- Cancellation of any of the reserved places up to 14 days before arrival will result in a cancellation charge equal to the deposit paid on those places. However, after we have received final details we make no administration charge for replacing a cancellation with another booking.
- Payment of the deposit for a number of places makes the group liable for payment of the full invoiced value of those places. Cancellation of any of the reserved places within 14 days of arrival will result in a cancellation charge to the full invoiced value of the cancelled places.
- The final payment is not refundable but we make no administration charge for replacing a cancellation with another booking.
- A refund will not be made if a group arrives later or leaves earlier than booked.

VARIATIONS

In certain cases these terms may be varied by mutual agreement.
