



Hyde Park School

This is a fun, stimulating summer programme featuring weekly projects. Each week the students learn English through a topic, such as theatre and Performance or Past, Present and Future. In addition students learn English through subjects including Math, Science, Technology and Drama.

There are also a weekly 'Discover London' Academic trip, one afternoon of sports and optional lunch time sports programmes. Students are divided into class by age group (10 – 14 and 14 – 17) and by level (beginners to advanced). Teachers are language and subject specialists with experience of working with 10 - 17 year old students.

Courses are run by Skola, an International Educational Group accredited by British Council and established over 40 years ago.

General Information

ACCOMMODATION

Home-stay or Residence accommodation is available. Students staying in Residence will be separated by age and sex. The residence has twin and triple rooms, wooden floors, no carpets, bathrooms, 2 kitchens, dining and lounge, a garden and wi-fi broadband. Students will be supervised at all times by a Head of House. Laundry service and room cleaning are included.

ACTIVITIES

The school organizes a fun stimulating summer programme, with plenty of projects, activities, sports and half a day trip.

TRANSFER

Transfers can be organised upon request. Various possibilities include taxi, coaches and minibus.

The school runs an Academic Year program. Please contact us for more information.

RESERVATION

To avoid having too many students of any one nationality at the school at any one time there are a limited number of places on every course for each nationality. Reservation should therefore be made as early as possible.

To make a reservation for a number of group places we must receive:

- a) The Group Reservation Form with as much detail as possible about the group.
- b) A deposit of £150 GBP per student to be irrevocably credited to our bank account for the exact number of places to be reserved.

Deposit for summer courses must be paid by the end of March. The balance of the total group invoice must be credited to our bank account no later than 21 days before the arrival date.

The Enrolment Form on its own though does not constitute a reservation and does not guarantee availability of places.

On receipt of the Enrolment Form we will send a Proforma invoice together with a Student Details Form which must be completed and returned to us with the full and final details of the students in the group no less than 30 days before the arrival date.

FINAL PAYMENT

The balance of the total group invoice must be credited no later than 21 days before the arrival date, otherwise we reserve the right to cancel the booking.

ENROLMENT

We cannot guarantee acceptance of any group or part of a group until a reservation has been properly made as detailed below. We reserve the right to refuse the enrolment of any student for any reason including inappropriate level of English.

PAYMENT

The deposit must be paid when you book your course. It is also possible to make full payment of fees at this stage. Full payment details will be provided.

When we have received your enrolment form and £150.00 deposit (per student) we will reserve the course and accommodation for you and send you a Certificate of Enrolment confirming your course dates and the total price.

Please note: We must receive full payment for your course at least 21 days before you arrive.

Cancellations

If you cancel your course because your visa application was refused we will refund 100% of fees paid on receipt of the original written visa refusal.

If you cancel your course or accommodation up to 21 days before the start date, we will refund the total fees paid minus the deposit. If you cancel your course less than 21 days before the start date, the full value of all fees paid, minus the deposit, will be transferred to another course of your choice at a later date.

If you wish to cancel all or part of your course or accommodation after your arrival 4 weeks' notice must be given. The balance of the accommodation fees will be refunded in full and the balance of the tuition fees will be transferred to another course at a later date. If less than the required notice period is given, 4 weeks' tuition and accommodation fees will still be deducted from the remaining balance.

CANCELLATIONS AND CHANGES FOR GROUPS

Cancellation of any of the reserved places up to 14 days before arrival will result in a cancellation charge equal to the deposit paid on those places. However, after we have received final details we make no administration charge for replacing a cancellation with another booking.

Payment of the deposit for a number of places makes the group liable for payment of the full invoiced value of those places. Cancellation of any of the reserved places within 14 days of arrival will result in a cancellation charge to the full invoiced value of the cancelled places.

The final payment is not refundable but we make no administration charge for replacing a cancellation with another booking.

A refund will not be made if a group arrives later or leaves earlier than booked.

VARIATIONS

In certain cases these terms may be varied by mutual agreement.
